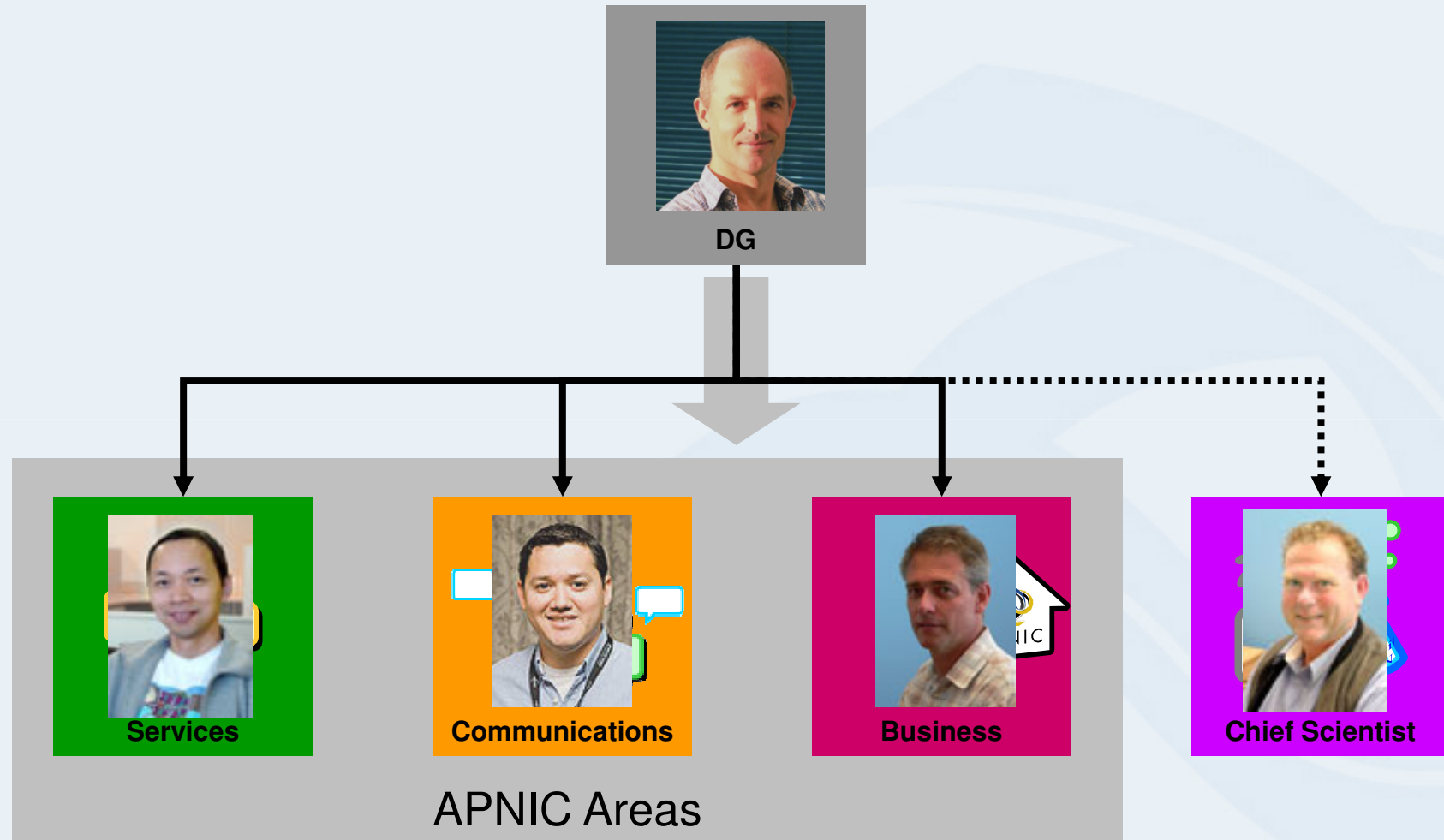

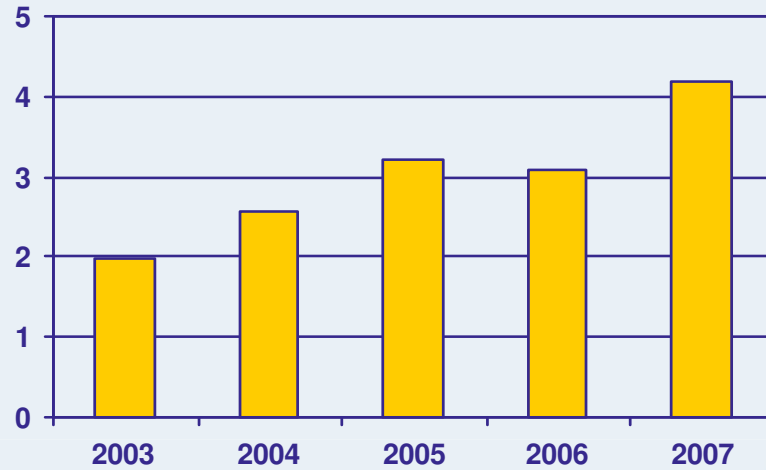

APNIC structure - 2008

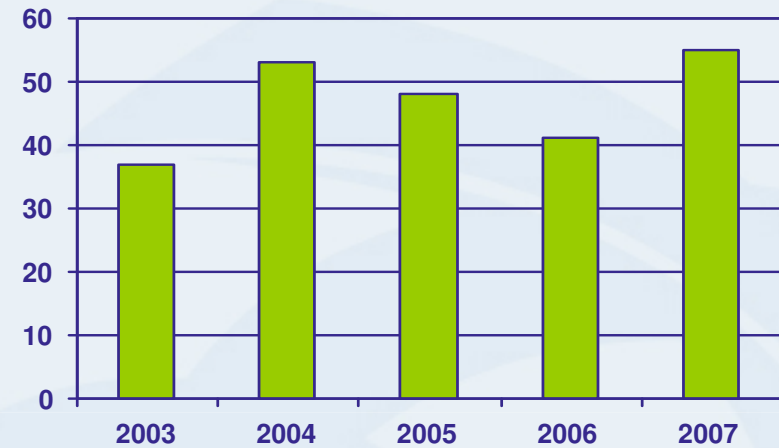

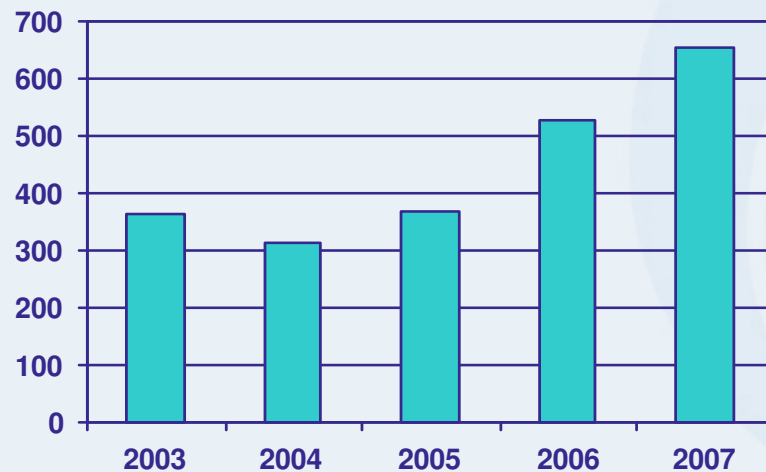
IPv4 - /8s



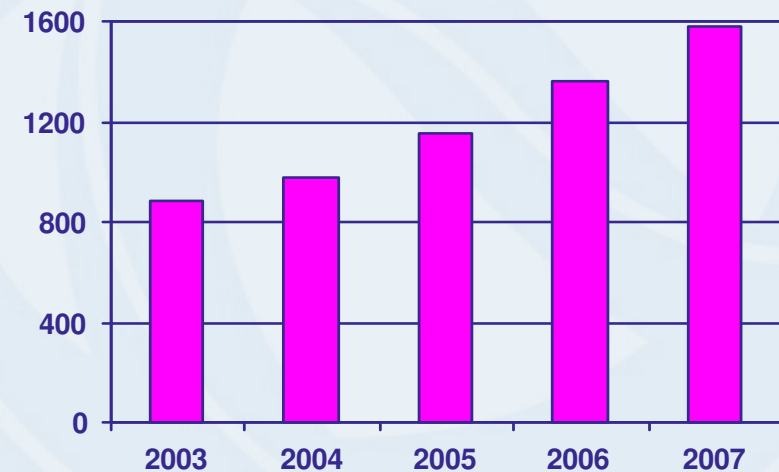
IPv6 - Prefixes



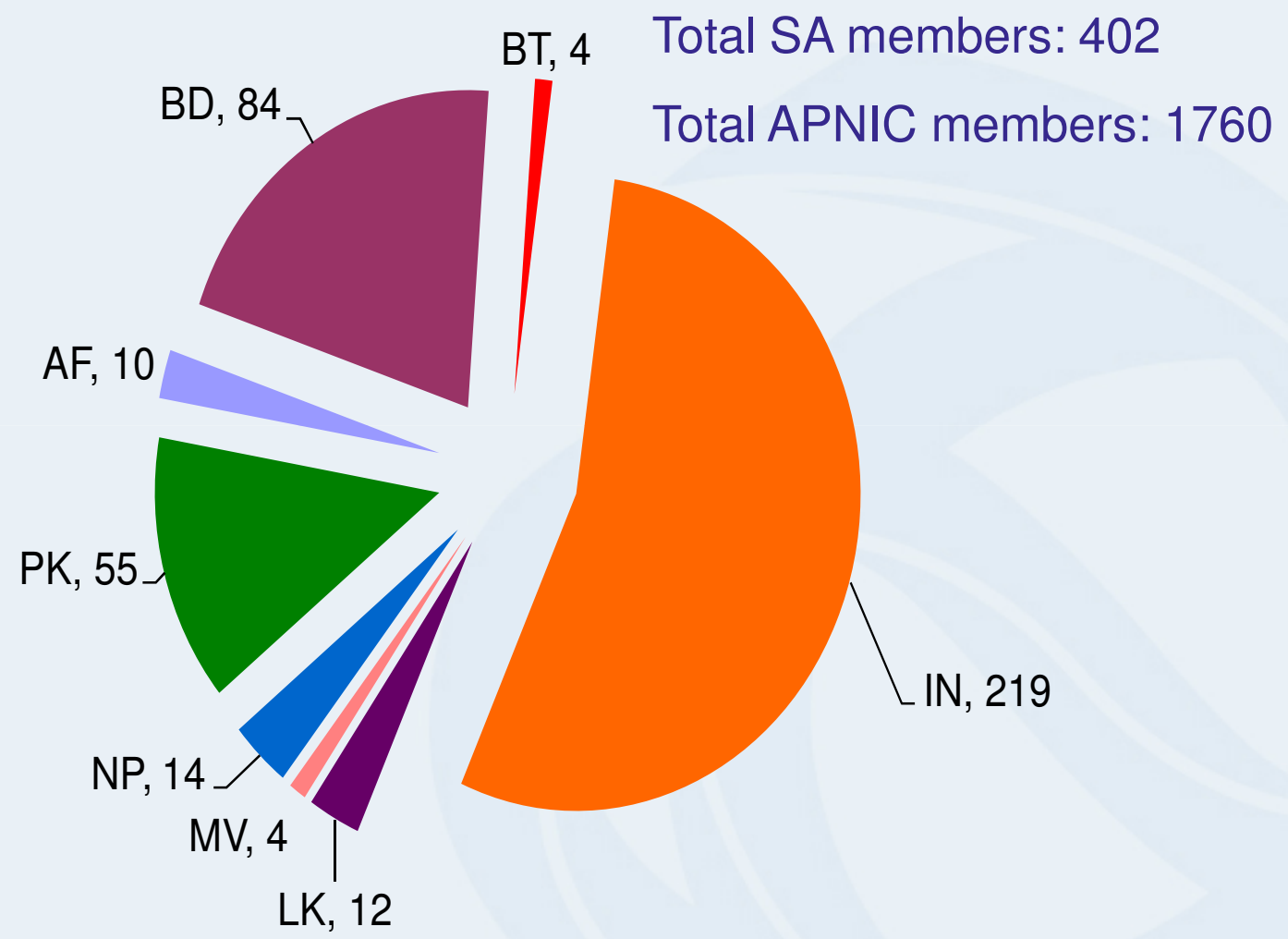
ASNs - Total



Members - Total

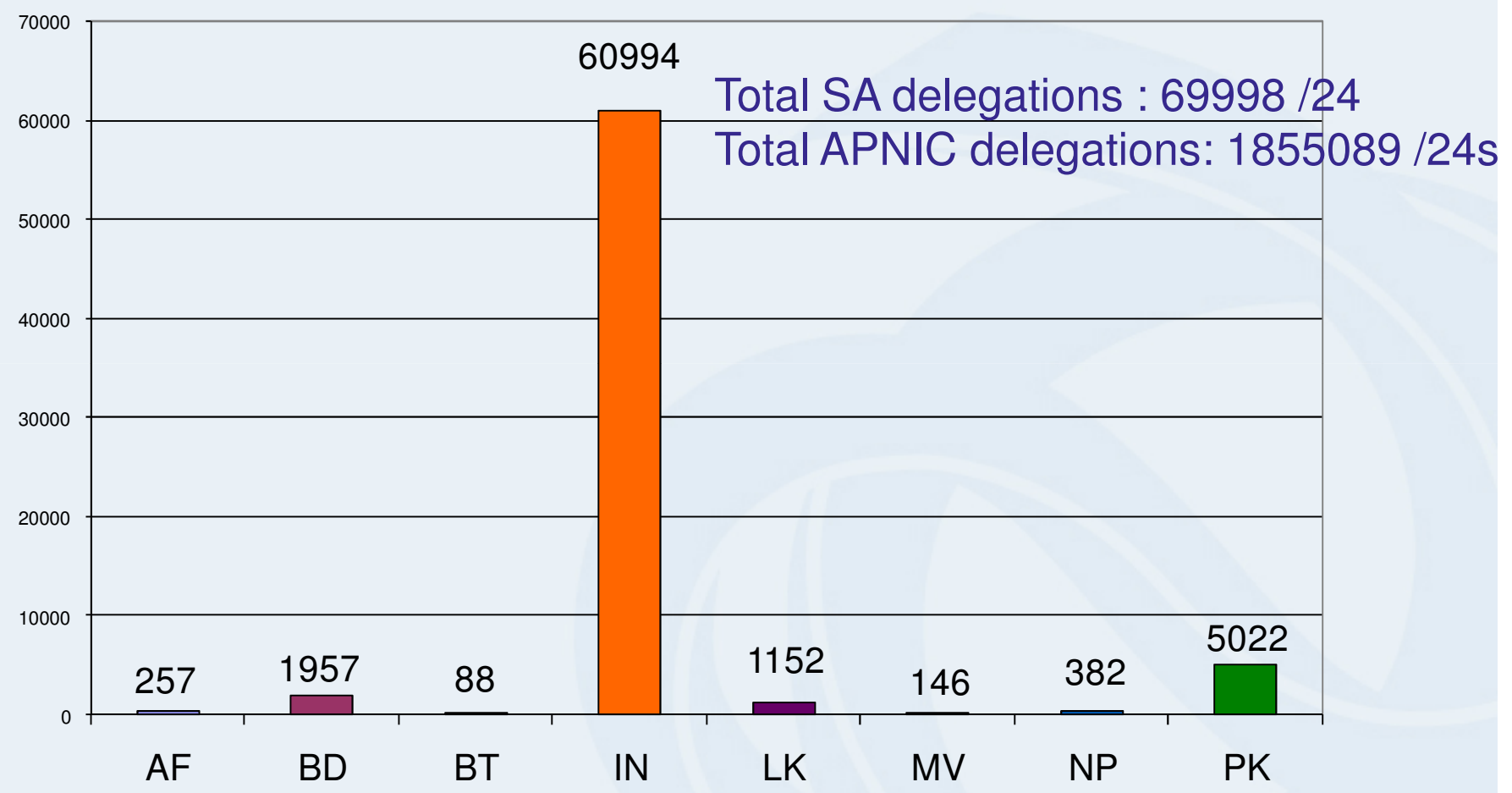


APNIC Members in South Asia

IPv6 delegations in South Asia

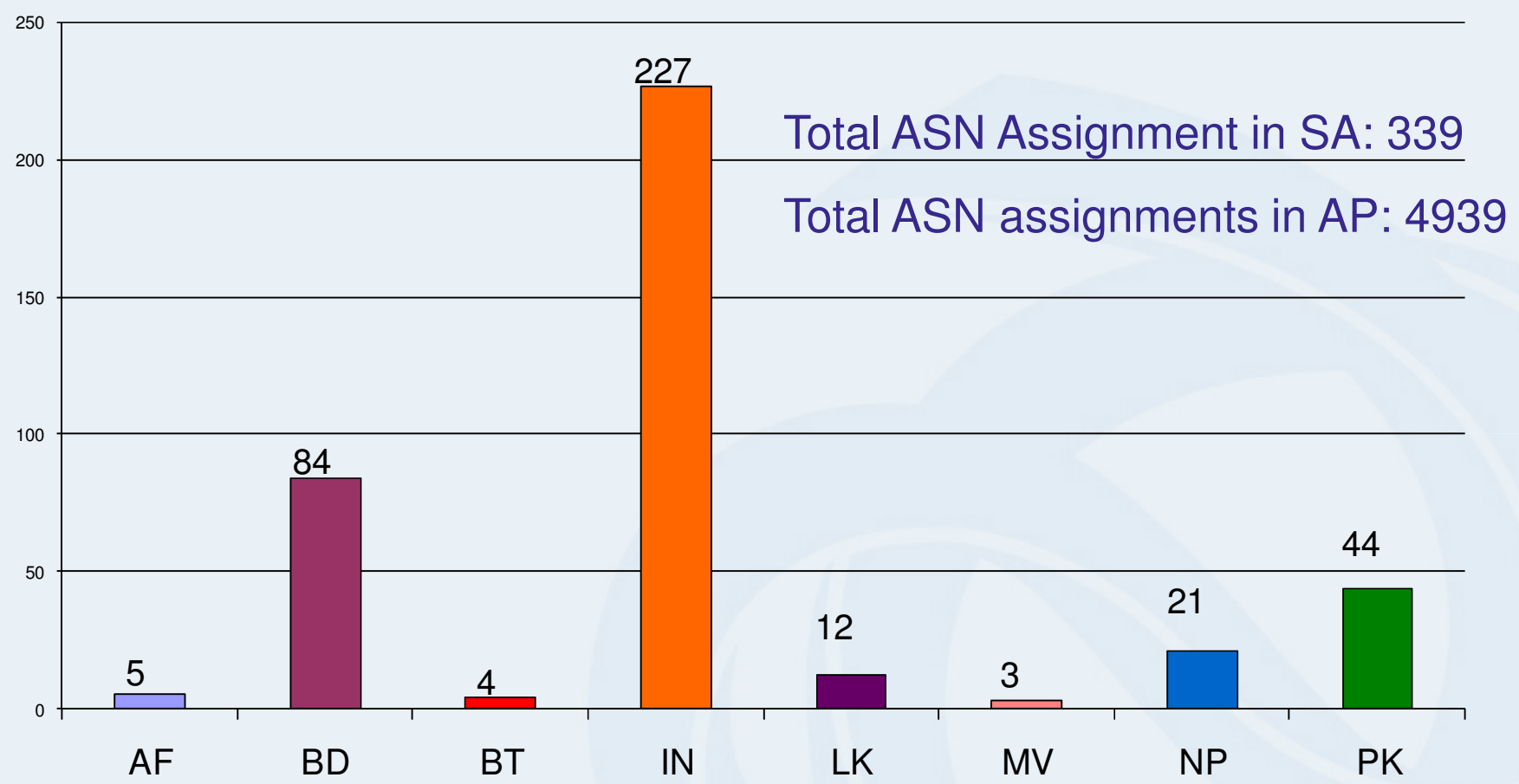

- Goal for 2008: Full support for IPv6

 - Dual stacks
 - Better IPv6 connectivity
- Communications
 - Training, Information, 'Promotion'...

Policy	Change	Status
Changing minimum IPv4 allocation size to /22	Change of minimum IPv4 allocation size from /21 to /22	Implemented
IPv6 initial allocation criteria change (section d)	Be existing LIR which makes IPv6 assignments or sub-allocations to other organisations and announce allocation within two years	Implemented

Proposal	Change	Overview
Prop-050	IPv4 resource transfers	Recognise transfer of IPv4 address space between APNIC members, and for it to be accurately registered
Prop-060	Change in the criteria for the recognition of NIRs in the APNIC region (APNIC-104)	NIR application may not need government's endorsement. Put through voting process to achieve support
