VISA to Bangladesh

Visa On Arrival:

- A. USA, Canada, Australia, New Zealand, Russian Federation, China, Japan, Singapore, Malaysia, South Korea, UAE, Saudi Arabia (KSA), Qatar, Kuwait, Oman, Bahrain and the countries of Europe.
- B. The nationals of those countries where there is no diplomatic mission of Bangladesh

Visa Requirements:

- a) Visa fees are to be paid in foreign currencies (US dollar, GB Pound/Euro etc.)
- b) Visitor must possess minimum USD 500 or its equivalent amount of foreign currency in cash or credit card
- c) Visitors must have return ticket
- d) Must have necessary documents to justify his/her visit

National Mosque

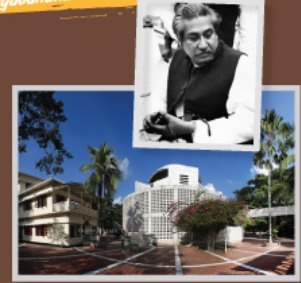

Language Movement Martyrs' Memorial



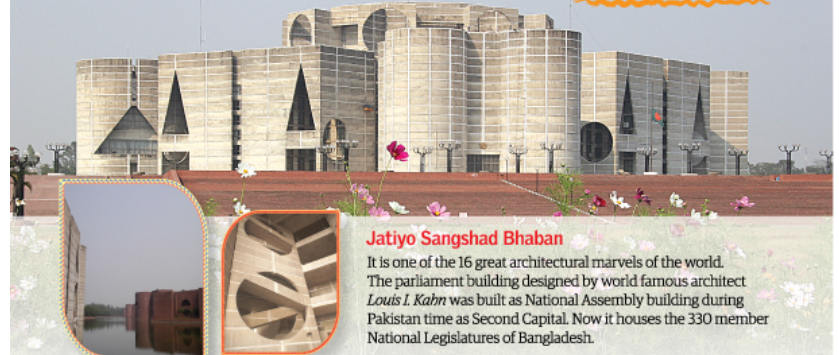
Shahid Minar
