About SANOG:

SANOG was started to bring together operators for educational as well as cooperation. SANOG provides a regional forum to discuss operational issues and technologies of interest to data operators in the South Asian Region.

As data networks has grown around the world, we took the initiative for a South Asian Network Operators Group (SANOG). This was in line with established practices like NANOG in North America, RIPE NCC Meetings in Europe and APRICOT in Asia. The meeting will provide a regional forum to discuss operational issues and technologies closer home for data operators in the South Asian Region. The definition includes Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Maldives, Nepal, Pakistan and Sri Lanka.

The first SANOG Meeting was held in Kathmandu, in January 2003, along side the CAN IT Conference 2003, which is the annual conference organized by the Computer Association of Nepal.



The Internet Service Providers Association of India (ISPAI) was set up in 1998 with a mission to 'Promote Internet/Broadband for the benefit of all'.

ISPAI is the collective voice of the ISP fraternity and by extension the entire Internet community. Over the years ISPAI has helped influence, shape and mould the telecom policies, so that ISPs and entrepreneurs in the business of Internet can setup and grow their services in an environment that is supportive and enabling.

ISPAI has access to and interacts frequently with international bodies and platforms and is frequently consulted by them on measures for future trends and growth of Internet. It works closely with the Government, the Regulator as well as the major Industry Chambers. It supports exchange of delegations, business visitors from across the globe which provides ISP members a chance to network widely and seek opportunities elsewhere too.

About NIXI:

NIXI is a not for profit Organization under section 25 of the companies Act 1956 and was registered on 19th June 2003. NIXI was ser up for peering of ISP's among themselves for the purpose of routing the domestic traffic within the country, instead of taking it all the way to US/Abroad, thereby resulting in better quality of service (reduced latency) and reduced bandwidth charges for ISP's by saving on International Bandwidth. NIXI is managed and operated ona neutral basis, in line with the best practices for such initiatives globally.

Indian Registry for Internet Names and Numbers (IRINN)

Govt. of India, Department of Electronics & Information Technology endorsed the operations of National Internet Registry (NIR) to National Internet Exchange of India (NIXI). NIR is an entity under the umbrella of a Regional Internet Registry (RIR) which is Asia Pacific Network Information centre (APNIC). NIR is entrusted with the task of coordinating IP Address allocation with other Internet resource management function at national level in the country. NIXI was recognized by APNIC in March 2012 to become the NIR for the country. The NIR has been named as Indian Registry for Internet Names and Numbers (IRINN). Collective efforts of NIXI and ISAPI have led to the formation of IRINN in the country.

IRINN is a division functioning under NIXI and provides allocation and registration services of Internet Protocol addresses (IPv4 & IPv6) and Autonomous System numbers to its Affiliates .It is a not-for-profit, Affiliates based entity, with the primary goal of allocation of Internet resources to its Affiliates.
